

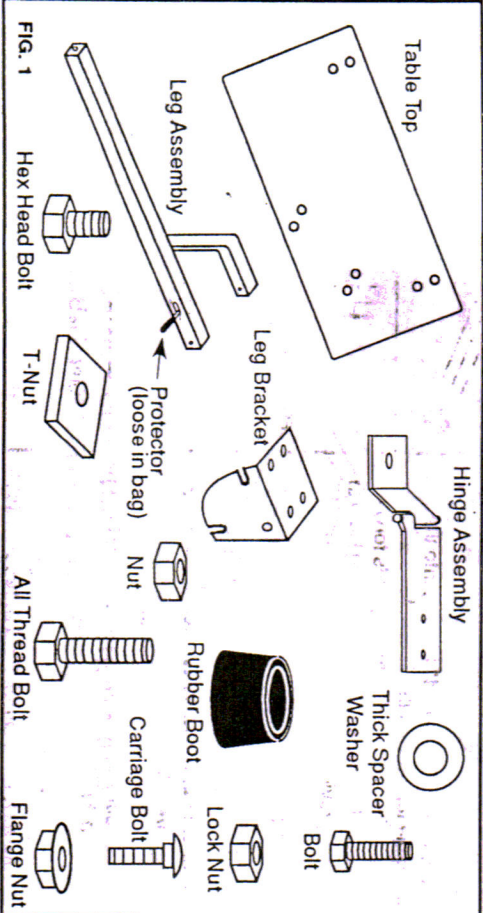
## TOOLS NEEDED

Tools needed for assembly of this table are a 1/4", 3/8", 1/2" and 5/16" socket wrench.

## UNPACKING AND CHECKING PARTS

Separate all parts from packing materials. Check your parts with the parts list shown on this page. Refer to Figure 1 if you are unsure about the description of any part. If parts are missing, delay your assembly of this Quick Fold Extension Table until you have obtained the missing part(s).

## ASSEMBLY

Read these instructions completely before beginning assembly of this table.

## QUICK FOLD EXTENSION TABLE

**CAUTION: AVOID PINCH POINTS WHEN ASSEMBLING, OPERATING OR STORING THIS QUICK FOLD EXTENSION TABLE.**

### TO ASSEMBLE THE FOLDING LEG

1. Place a leg bracket onto the leg assembly. Using a bolt (1/4"-20 x 1 1/2") and lock nut (1/4"-20) fasten the leg bracket onto the leg assembly. Be careful not to over tighten the nut and prevent the leg bracket from rotating on the leg assembly. Follow the above steps for the second leg bracket. See Figure #2.

2. Place four carriage bolts (1/4"-20 x 1") into the top rear of the table top. Mount the folding leg assembly so that in the collapsed position the leg folds forward toward the front of the table. Secure the folding leg with the flange nuts provided (1/4"-20). See Figure #3.

### TO ASSEMBLE THE HINGES

3. Place four carriage bolts (1/4"-20 x 1") into the top front of the table top. Mount the hinge assembly on the underside of the table top using the flange nuts provided (1/4"-20). Do not over tighten the flange nuts or you may damage the table by putting the bolts through. Make sure that the hinge assembly is face up. See Figure #4.

### MOUNTING TABLE TO THE BT3000

1. Slide the T-Nuts into the bottom of the back rail as shown in Figure #5.
2. Insert the hex head bolt (5/16"-18 x 1/2") with the thick spacer washer through the bottom of the hinge hole. Screw the bolt into the special T-Nut provided, after positioning the T-Nut in the bottom slot of the BT3000 rear rail. Secure the bolt firmly. See Figure #5.

### OPERATION OF THE TABLE

1. To position for storage pull down on the spring loaded handle and collapse the leg flush to the table. The leg will lock into the folded position for storage.
2. To position for use simply pull down on the spring loaded handle and fold the leg to its full extension. The leg will lock into the extended position for use as an outfeed table.
